KADDISH tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn, took over in the stretch but was outfinished in the final stages. AL BASHA was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. ROMAN SILVER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch drive. EIGHTEENTHOFMARCH was on the inside into the far turn with no rally in the stretch. DOUBLE PITTSBURGH angled off the rail into the far turn while no threat. ANOTHER DANCER stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late.
