GATORIZE reserved early, moved out four wide once in the turn, came wider for the drive, made a quick move to the lead in midstretch and drew off late. ROSE RUN forwardly placed, moved up five wide late on the turn but lodged only a mild bid to be second best. JONES TIME closest to the pace three wide, challenged once in the stretch, held on to inside the final furlong and tired. LAVENHAM stumbled at the start, was outrun to the stretch and improved her position while no threat. TOSCA'S KISS outrun early, raced six wide out of the turn and could not threaten. VICK'S VIOLET within striking distance off the inside, tired. INSURE close up from the start, was trapped inside and just behind the leader to the stretch, angled out a bit and tired. THUNDERING JILL set the pace just off the rail and gave way in the drive. MILLION BELLS five wide with three furlongs to go, was no factor. DARE prompted the pace in the four path and stopped.
